Why this project?

This is not an ordinary charitable act. It is a message, a test, and a beginning.

1	Restoring hope to a forgotten community Letting the villagers know that there are people who are aware of their suffering and who care, after decades of neglect.
2	Protecting lives from a real danger Rockfalls have continued since the earthquake. A safe path for fast escape protects families in emergencies.
3	A test of trust and credibility Succeeding in this simple project opens the door to more ambitious initiatives for the Alliance and its donors.
